PARENT GUIDELINES FOR MINI JUMP'N'PLAY PARTIES

We want your child's Mini Jump 'n' Play party at Bluecoat Sports to be a fantastic and fun experience. However, we also need it to be safe for all concerned. For that reason, we have set out some guidelines below so that you know what we expect from you as part of this party and what you can expect from us.

What you can expect from us

<u>Staff</u>

We will provide a trained and friendly party host who will ensure that your party runs smoothly. This host is not there to run your party – that is your responsibility – but they will ensure that your party runs smoothly and assist in any way they can.

<u>Equipment</u>

We will provide you with our Monkey bouncy castle, Jungle play-zone, a soft play area and bikes 'n trikes for the party children to use. These equipment choices have been carefully selected to cater to the age range of your party, ensuring that every child finds something exciting to engage with during the party.

What we expect from you

Adult Supervision

While our party host is there to assist with safety precautions, we request that parent(s) / guardians actively supervise their children during the party. Parent(s) / guardians should be aware of the following safety measures to ensure that all children are kept safe:

- Safety mats should be kept tightly in place in front of the Bouncy Castle;
- Children must be stopped from going behind the Bouncy Castle or accessing the blower;
- Soft play equipment should only be used on the matted area provided;
- Benches be aware that benches are hard surfaces and falls onto these will cause injury;
- Only equipment provided for the party should be used in this area;

Clothing

We kindly ask everyone to remove shoes before entering the play areas to maintain cleanliness of the equipment. Socks must be worn at all times. All participants should wear suitable clothing for active play. Any loose or dangling accessories should be removed before using the equipment.

Listen to and respect our staff

Our staff will do all that they can to ensure that your party is great fun. If they deem something to be unsafe, we expect you to ensure that all those attending the party listen to and follow their guidance.
